



complete neighborhoods provide:

- defined character and high-quality design;
- public utilities (water, sewer, and storm sewer);
- quality public spaces;
- a variety of housing types;
- schools, childcare, commercial, recreation, and other amenities within walking distance (1/4 to 1/2 mile) of residences; and
- connection by complete streets that are safe for all modes of travel.



rural areas provide:

- viable wildlife habitat and connections between wildlife habitat
- natural scenic vistas
- agricultural and undeveloped open space
- abundance of landscape over built form
- limited, detached single family residential development
- minimal additional nonresidential development
